- Science provides us with a wonderful forum for loving our neighbor. We should not do so uncritically.
- We need to bring a solid philosophy about how Christianity and science interact.
  - o They don't interact (unacceptable).
  - The rise of science is gradually leading to the elimination of primitive religious belief (not adopted by Christians).
  - Science cannot make authoritative claims (unacceptable).
  - Critical realism, we cannot know exhaustively, but we can know things truly.
